
**FISCAL IMPACT:** None.

**BACKGROUND:**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Clark County Regional Flood Control District (RFCD) Board of Directors is calendared for May 14, 2020. The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) is rescheduling their meeting of May 14, 2020 to May 21, 2020, pursuant to NRS 354.596.4, which states that budget hearings must be held by the governing body not sooner than the third Monday in May and not later than the last day in May. The District's budget is submitted to the State as a component of Clark County's, therefore the County will include our budget during their public hearing.

Historically, the RTC and RFCD have held their meetings on the same day. Therefore, it is recommended that the RFCD Board meeting be rescheduled to May 21, 2020.
